MAIN FINDINGS



51% of the surveyed organizations does not have a Sustainable Logistics Management Plan (SLP)



Lack of action of the Interministerial Commission on Sustainability

Unsatisfactory implementation of sustainability initiatives by the Federal Government organizations, due to deficiencies in planning, coordination and adherence to sustainable development requirements.

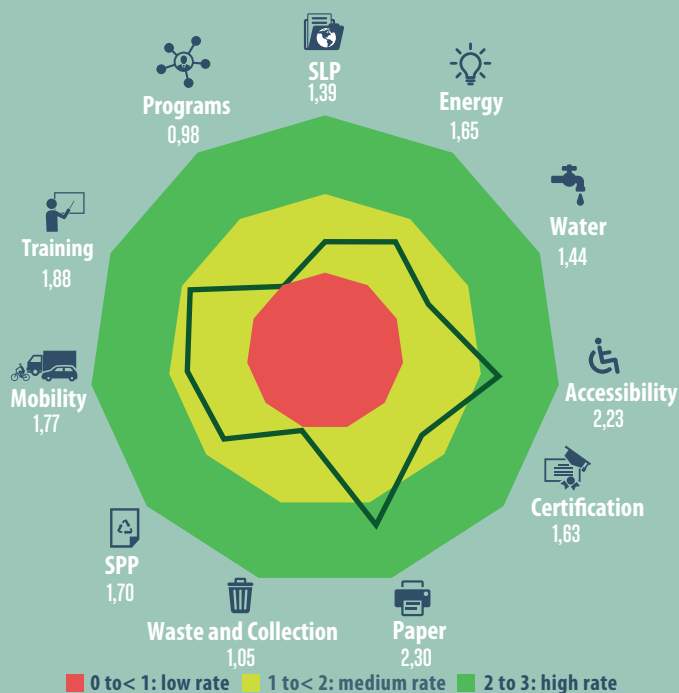


Less than 1% of public procurement are Sustainable Public Procurement (SPP)



Absence of Sustainability Division hinders the sustainability initiatives
