





#### Minutes of the 24<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the INTOSAI Working Group on IT Audit (Warsaw, Poland, 29 and 30 June 2015)



#### Minutes

The 24<sup>th</sup> meeting of the INTOSAI Working Group on IT Audit (WGITA) was held at Warsaw, Poland on 29 and 30 June 2015. The WGITA participants were also invited by SAI-Poland to participate in the joint activities of the WGITA and EUROSAI Working Group on Information Technology on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2015. The WGITA meeting was presided over by Mr. Shashi Kant Sharma, Comptroller & Auditor General of India and Chairman of the Working Group. The list of delegates who attended the meeting as members and observers are attached as Annexure. The proceedings of the 24<sup>th</sup> WGITA are as follows:

#### Agenda item No. 1: Welcome Address by Mr. Krzysztof Kwiatkowski, President of the Supreme Audit Office of Poland

Mr. Krzysztof Kwiatkowski, President of the Polish Supreme Audit Office welcomed all the participants and expressed his appreciation for the work of the group, particularly on the elaboration of the ISSAI 5300 standard. He was convinced that INTOSAI members were anxious to see the results of the meeting as this is the group that tries to address how auditors could catch up with the dynamic IT environment in their work. 
