Doctor and Master of Civil Procedural Law (PUC-SP). Specialist in Civil Law. He was a Legal Advisor and Attorney at superior courts. During eleven years, he was a legislative aide of the Federal Senate, having jointed the career by passing a public examination in 2003, in the area of civil procedural law. He was part of the Committee of Jurists created by the President of the Federal Senate with the purpose of writing the draft project of the new Civil Procedure Code. He represented the Presidency of the Federal Senate at the Interinstitutional Committee of Management of the 2nd Republican Pact. He was a member of the National Justice Council (2011-2013) and the National Council of the Public Ministry (2009-2011), nominated by the Federal Senate in the quality of “a citizen with remarkable legal knowledge and unblemished reputation.” During four years, he was the General Consultant of the Federal Senate (2007-2011).

He is a professor of the under graduate and graduate courses of the Public Law Institute of Brasilia (Instituto Brasiliense de Direito Público-IDP) and a visiting professor of graduate courses of the Specialization, Training and Extension Office of the São Paulo Catholic University (COGEAE/PUC-SP). He is the author of several scientific articles and of the book “Repercussão geral: perspectivas histórica, dogmática e de direito comparado - questões processuais” (General repercussion: historic, dogmatic and compared law perspectives – procedural issues), published by Revista dos Tribunais Publishers. He organized the collection of articles “Constituição de 1988: o Brasil 20 anos depois” (1988 Constitution: Brazil 20 years later), with 5 volumes, published by the Technical Editions Department of the Federal Senate and the special issue of the Legislative Information Journal on the new Civil Procedure Code. He is the Secretary General of the Brazilian Association of Constitutional Procedural Law.
